



Your Voice, Our Future - Rule Change Proposals

The BFA is a membership led association

If you are an eligible member of the association this means that you have the opportunity to put forward formal proposals to make changes to our constitution and/or our rules of racing as part of our Annual General Meeting where they will be considered and voted on by the membership.

Not many organisations provide members with this type of opportunity as it is members' proposals that, if voted in, change the way we govern the association and impact the way in which we race and the rules that we apply to our racing. It is not down to committee members or any of the officials, for example Head Judges, Judges etc within the association, it is down to you the members.

So, to help members looking to submit proposals the Rules Working Party created the BFA AGM Proposals form. This form provides guidance to members on how to submit their proposal whilst ensuring that all proposals will follow the same format.
