 To scan a document on **iphone**, use the built-in Files app to access the camera scanner. **Open the Files app**: on your iPhone. **Tap the "Scan Documents"**: option, often found by tapping the three-dot ellipsis icon. **Position the document**: in the camera's view, **holding the camera directly above the document**. The phone will either automatically capture the scan, or you can tap the shutter button to do it yourself. **Tap "Keep Scan"**: and then "Save" to save the document as a PDF in the Files app.  
 To scan a document on **Android**, use the built-in Google Drive app: Open the app, tap the + (plus) icon, select Scan, **hold the camera directly above the document**. Capture the image by tapping the shutter button, use tools to add pages. Finally, tap Done to name the document and save it as a PDF.
