# **SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. B.F.A. rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
- 2. The tournament organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any person not in good standing with the B.F.A.
- 3. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament.
- 4. It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for its class and running order.
- 5. No person shall impugn the decisions of the Head Judge or Judges.
- 6. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 7. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 8. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
  - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
  - b. A danger to safety of any person or animal
  - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
- 9. All dogs enter into the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 10. All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 11. If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
- 12. No alcohol is to be consumed within or around the ring.

#### 13. NO BARBEQUES TO BE USED DIRECTLY ON THE GRASS

- 14. Starters will be run based on current BFA rules. Jump heights and assistance at the box are left to the discretion of individual teams, based on the ability of their team. Any Non BFA Members competing in Starters are the responsibility of the Primary Team Captain.
- 15. NOTE: THE RIVER DON RUNS THROUGH SEATON PARK. SWIMMING YOUR DOGS IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.

## **DIRECTIONS**

Please note: Seaton Park is located in Old Aberdeen near the university and beach. Sat Nav / google maps may take you through the city centre via Union Street, the shopping centre of Aberdeen. To avoid the city centre (advisable for rush hour traffic on Friday night) programme the Sat Nav to go via Anderson Drive / Westburn Road. The route below takes you around the city centre to Seaton Park.

#### From the South:

- Arriving on the A90 from the south: go over the Bridge of Dee
- At roundabout go straight ahead onto Anderson Drive.
- Go through 4 roundabouts, going straight along A90.
- Turn right at traffic lights onto Westburn Road. The turn is just after a Shell Garage on the RHS of road.
- \*Go straight along Westburn Road, passing the hospital and further along passing Westburn Park both on LHS of road.
- Westburn Road becomes Hutcheon Street.
- At the large roundabout, take the second exit, signposted A956 / Old Aberdeen down Mounthooley Way.
- At the traffic lights turn left onto King Street / A965.
- Go past an Esso garage on the RHS of road and then the University on the LHS of road.
- At the small roundabout, go straight on.
- You pass a BP garage on the LHS of road, get into the left lane.
- Take the next left turn at the traffic lights, signposted Seaton Park.
- The park entrance is on the LHS of road.

#### From the West:

- From the A944, bear left onto the Lang Stracht
- At the traffic lights with Anderson Drive, go straight ahead onto Westburn Road.
- Follow the directions from \* above.
