We will be holding a Double Elimination tournament split into appropriate divisions with dogs racing against another lane. Dog times must be declared and a break out rule will apply. Div 1 will not be subject to the Break Out rule. Other divisions will have varying break outs, depending on diversity of dog times. Eg; Div 2 may have a break out of 0.15 sec per dog, whereas division 5 may have a 0.5 sec break out, 2 break outs will result in disqualification so please be as accurate as possible when declaring a time for your dog/s. Maximum height for all races will be 12”

Judge and Ring Party will be required per division
Format and divisions will be dependant on dog entries and are subject to change.

Full details and explanation of DE will be published before the competition

Trophies will be awarded to Pairs winners, rosettes down to third.

Rosettes will be awarded to Singles winners down to third place

Please note the DE will only apply to the singles and pairs tournament, Open and Starter races will be in Round Robin Format.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admissions to the event any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area.
Mating of dog at the show is not permitted.
4. A dog must be withdrawn from the competition if it is:
 - a) Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease.
 - b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
 - c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
5. It is the team captain's responsibility to ensure the team is available for their class and running order.
6. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of any unforeseen circumstances.
7. If Circumstances make it necessary to cancel the Tournament, the organiser(s) reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.
8. All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser(s) cannot accept any responsibility for damage, or loss howsoever caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
9. All owners/handlers Must clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
10. Current BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
