Declared times MUST be submitted by the Tournament Organiser at least 14 days prior to the Tournament, If a declared time is not submitted then the last available recorded time will be used (even if this is over 4 months old), if there are no previous times recorded for a team then a time of 22.00 seconds will be used as a declared time. A declared time may be submitted - it must be at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  second faster or  $\frac{1}{2}$  second slower than the Team's seeded time and will be subject to the Team break-out rule. Teams not on the seed list must submit a time and will be subject to the team break-out rule. The break-out rule does not apply in Division 1.

## **BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.**

- Event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing with the BFA.
- The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the team is available in their division and running order.
- All dogs are entered in the event at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage injury or loss, however caused, to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
  
- All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so, will be asked to leave the venue.
- No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area.
- Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
  - Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases.
  - A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
  - Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.

If circumstances make it necessary for a tournament to be cancelled, the organiser(s) reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.

## Directions to Venue

### From South and East

Continue straight to stay on A1

Take the A198/B6371 exit toward B1361/North Berwick/Prestonpans/Cockenzie/Tranent 0.3 mi

At the roundabout, take the 4th exit onto A198 0.3 mi

At the roundabout, take the 1st exit and stay on A198 0.3 mi

At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto B1361 0.3 mi

Sharp left 410 ft

Turn right 0.2 mi

Turn right Destination will be on the right 469 ft

### From North and West

Merge onto A720 Edinburgh City Bypass

Go through 1 roundabout (Sheriffhall) 9.9 mi

At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto the A1 ramp to Berwick upon Tweed/Tranent/Haddington/North Berwick/Cockenzie/Port Seton 0.3 mi

Merge onto A1 4.5 mi

Take the A198 exit toward B6371/B1361/North Berwick/Prestonpans/Cockenzie/Tranent 0.2 mi

At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto A198 0.4 mi

At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto B1361 0.3 mi

Sharp left 410 ft

Turn right 0.2 mi

Turn right

Destination will be on the right 469 ft
