- The event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entry & admission to the event of any person not in good standing with the BFA.
- No person shall carry out punitive or harsh treatment of a dog whilst at the event.
- Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area.
- The mating of dogs is not allowed at any sanctioned BFA event.
- A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:

Suffering from an infection disease

A danger to the safety of any person or animal

Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete

- It is the team captains responsibility to ensure that the team is available for their races, running order and ring party duties on time.
- The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- All owners and handlers enter their dogs at their and their pets own risk and whilst every care is taken, the event organiser(s) will not accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs persons or property whilst at the event.
- All dog owners/handlers must clean up after their dog(s). Anyone failing to do so, will be asked to leave the venue.
- BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
- All teams entering the show are expected to assist with ring party duties as required by the event organiser(s).
- Dogs must be kept under control at all times whilst attending the event.
