Show Rules and Regulations

- 1) The event organisers reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
- 2) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 3) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- 4) A dog must be withdrawn from the competition if it is:
 - a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases;
 - b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal;
 - c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- 5) It is the Team Captain's responsibility to ensure the team is available for their class and running order.
- 6) No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- 7) The organisers reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 8) All dogs are entered in this event at their owner's risk and, whilst every care is taken, the event organisers cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss, however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 9) We have an excellent venue and it is most important that all owners/handlers clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 10) If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the tournament, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.
- 11.) Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.
