Show Rules and Regulations

- 1) The event organisers reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing, within the BFA.
- 2) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- 3) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 4) A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases;
 - b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal;
 - c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- 5) It is the Team Captain's responsibility to ensure the Team is available for their class and running order.
- 6) No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- 7) The organisers reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 8) All dogs are entered in this event at their owner's risk and, whilst every care will be taken, the event organisers cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss, however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 9) **All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.**
- 10) If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the tournament, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.
- 11) Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.



Our tournament will take place at Beckett's Farm in a securely fenced 10 acre field, with plenty of room for camping and to exercise the dogs. There is a water point. We will provide chemical toilets, and elsan facilities.

In the morning there will be food and hot drinks for sale on site.

For lunch, Beckett's Farm shop and restaurant are about 400 yards away. The shop has a bakery, butchers, greengrocers and off-licence. It also sells a wide range of sandwiches and has a hot food takeaway.

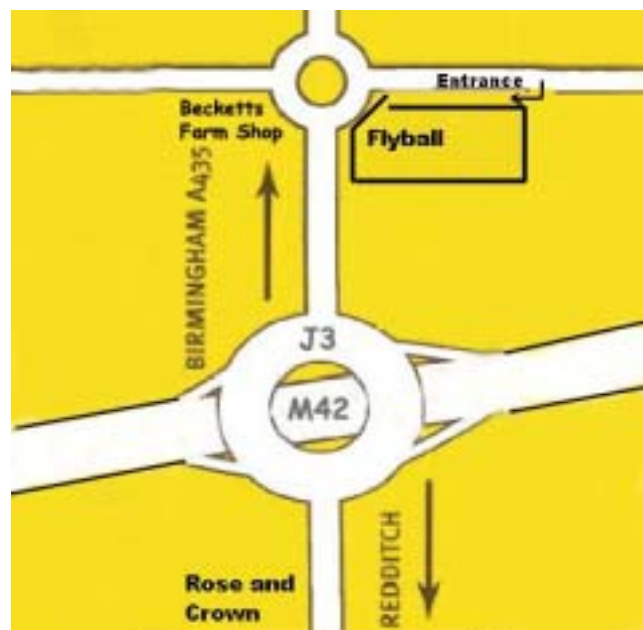
For campers, if you don't want to cook, there are local pubs in Wythall for evening meals or you can drive into Kings Heath (4½ miles) for a range of restaurants.
