7. All dogs enter in the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the tournament organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 8. All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.**
9. BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
