## **Eggborough May 2010**

### **Show rules and regulations**

1. The event organiser reserves the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any person not in good standing with the BFA.
2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs at the event is not allowed.
4. A dog must be withdrawn from the competition if it is:-
  - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease.
  - b. A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
  - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
5. It is the team captains responsibility to ensure that the team is available for their class and running order.
6. No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
7. The organiser reserves the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
8. All dogs are entered in this event at their owners risk and, whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
9. All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs anywhere in the grounds. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
10. If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the tournament, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.

**Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Tournament.**

### **Notes**

Team Captains/ Managers are responsible for ensuring that all members of their teams and accompanying party are informed of the rules and regulations pertaining to this tournament along with the conditions of the Eggborough Social Club.

The club requires the names of each person attending and which vehicles (car reg nos.) they belong to **with applications. (Late applications will not have use of club facilities)** All adults **registering** will become temporary members of the club entitling them to use the club facilities during the normal opening hours i.e. 7.00 am – 10.30 pm. Hot meals may be available during these hours. It would be helpful to the stewards to know how many will require lunches especially Sunday carvery.

**Dogs must be on a lead at all times during the weekend** except when racing or in the exercise area. No dogs are allowed on the golf area. There are numerous places in the vicinity outside the power station grounds where dogs may be exercised off the lead. **All parts of grounds require pick up of excrement.**

**Directions** The tournament is to be held at Eggborough Power Station Social Club grounds Leave the M62 at Junction 34 Take the A19 towards Selby. The power Station is 1.5mls on the right with the entrance marked.
