All dogs entered in starters or fun classes must be 12 months old or over on the day of the competition.

Handlers competing, who are not current BFA members, must supply their name and address and be prepared to abide by the BFA rules and policies and the show rules and regulations.

Show rules and regulations

1. The event organisers reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
2. It is the team captains responsibility to ensure the team is available for their class and running order.
3. No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
4. The organisers reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of **unforeseen** circumstances.
5. All dogs are entered in this event at their owners risk and, whilst every care will be taken, the event organisers cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
6. All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs.
Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
7. If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.

Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.

Directions to Tai Lawr, Anglesey

From Chester take **A55** (West) to North Wales and Anglesey

Cross the Britannia Bridge onto Isle of Anglesey, continue West on **A55** for approx 14 miles

Leave the **A55** at **Junction 5** signposted **A5 (Bryngwran)**

At double roundabout, over **A55**, follow signs for **A5 (Bryngwran)**. On reaching **A5**, turn left.

Bryngwran is the first village. Slow down at pub (on left) and turn sharp left at the Bryngwran Post Office.

Follow the road out of village, passing under **A55**. Straight on at first crossroads and pass Garage on left. Turn right at next crossroads (white cottage on right) into lane with signposts to Camping and Caravan Site and No Through Road.

Follow lane to bottom of hill, bear right, over small bridge, over cattle grid (Tyn Liddiate caravan site on left) and **Tai Lawr** is next on the left. (Name on gate)
