SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The tournament organisers(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any persons not in good standing with the BFA
2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament
3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
4. A dog must be withdrawn from the tournament if it is:
 1. Suffering from an infectious or contagious disease
 2. A danger to the safety of any person or animal
 3. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
5. It is the Team Captain's responsibility to ensure the team is available for their division and running order
6. The organizers(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances
7. All dogs enter in the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the tournament organisers(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event
8. All owners/ handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 9. BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the Sanction Tournament**
10. No alcohol to be consumed within or around the ring
11. If Circumstances make it necessary to cancel the tournament, the organizers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.

12. By entering this competition, you must be able to run on either day. We will endeavour to accommodate teams, but no guarantees are made. We hold the right to keep any entry fees of teams who enter and then say that they cannot race on a certain day.

Directions to Penny Farm, Preston New Road Blackpool

Exit M6 Junction 32 onto M55 to Blackpool

Exit M55 Junction 4 (A583)

Top of slip road Take the 1st exit left onto A583

(Follow brown signs to penny farm)

Straight across next roundabout

Carry straight on at traffic Lights. (Heading towards Kirkham)

Penny Farm is approx ½ mile on your Right.

Pass Main entrance and approx 300yds further down turn right
