Information

- (1) This is a limited indoor flyball competition (sanctioned by the BFA) run on rubber matting, with a maximum entry of 30 open teams. No refunds will be given unless the space can be filled.
- (2) Should on any day the entry fall below the limit, a STARTERS DIVISION may be organised.
- (3) All entries will be taken strictly in the order received. Each team will be treated as an individual entry [BFA rules 4.1 (g)]
- (4) Unless there are spaces, no entries will be accepted after the closing date.

(5) DIRECTIONS : POST CODE CH5 1SA

From North or East via M62, M60, or M6 to M56. Travel to the end of the M56 towards Queensferry & N. Wales (Note: roadworks from there on A5117 & part of A550 for ... miles 40 mph limit). Carry on A550 past Sealand RAF and onto A494. Cross the River and railway line before turning off towards Queensferry (B5441) & Shotton (B5129). Keep in R.Hand lane on the slip road. Go under dual carriageway still in R hand lane avoiding slip road to A494

***After the slip road move to L hand lane and to Traffic lights by Azda Hypermarket. This is the A5129 signposted to Shotton and (also is the N Wales Coast Road). Deeside Leisure Centre & Ice Rink are a short distance on the Right just before the pedestrian bridge.*

*From N.Wales via A55. After Ruthin turn onto A494 towards Birkenhead & M56 Then from ** above.*

*From Midlands M6, Jnc 16 (A500) towards Nantwich then onto A51 via Tarporley towards Chester/N. Wales. Where you meet A55 turn towards N.Wales. Then look for Birkenhead and M56 signs, turn onto A494 then as ** above.*

Show Rules and Regulations

- (1) The Event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
- (2) No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
- (3) Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- (4) A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is :
 - (a) Suffering from infectious or contagious diseases.
 - (b) A danger to the safety of any person or animal.
 - (c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- (5) It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for their class and running order.
- (6) No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges.
- (7) The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- (8) All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Event Organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- (9) No alcohol can be consumed within or around the ring.
- (10) All owners/handlers must clean up after their dog. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- (11) If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
- (12) Current BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.
