## **ADDRESS**

Uttoxeter Racecourse Wood Ln, Uttoxeter ST14 8BD

## **DIRECTIONS**

- From the North West - M6 to Junction 15, then follow signs for A50 Uttoxeter/Derby
- From the North East - M1 to Junction 24a, straight onto the A50 following signs for Uttoxeter/Derby.
- From the South and South West - From M5(J4a) or M40 (J3a), join the M42 (J7). Exit M42 at Junction 9 (Lichfield) follow signs for Lichfield and A38 (Burton/Derby). Exit A38 at A50 (Uttoxeter/Stoke). Alternatively; From M5 (J8) or M42 (J7), join M6 (North). Exit at Junction 14 and take A513 to Stafford, then A518 (Uttoxeter).
- From the South East - M1 To Junction 23a, the A50 (Uttoxeter/Stoke). Once in Uttoxeter follow the brown signs to Wood Lane and take the second turning on the left sign posted Main Entrance and Conference Centre.

We advise visitors to type Uttoxeter Racecourse into the sat nav, by using the postcode ST14 8BD or you can use what3words [what3words \[///nurses.bead.perfectly\]\(https://www.what3words.com/#!/nurses.bead.perfectly\)](https://www.what3words.com/#!/nurses.bead.perfectly)

## ARRIVAL TIMES

No arrivals before 2pm on Wednesday. Anyone arriving before 2pm will be turned away.

**There is a 5mph speed limit at all times on site**

## CHAMPIONSHIPS FORMAT

### SPEED TRIALS

Seed times will be taken on the 17th July 2026, the last qualifying competition will be the weekend of 11th & 12th July 2026.

Speed Trials (ST) for all Open Teams (Thursday): Teams will be placed into divisions based on their seed time. 3 races of 3 legs (block), no break out will be applicable in ST's to encourage teams to go as fast as possible. Any dog wishing to take part in the Championship racing on Saturday or Sunday will need to run at least 3 legs in ST's.

Following Speed Trials, teams will be re - seeded and placed into divisions based on their fastest time.

All teams, with the exception of Division 1, will run as 6 team divisions RR racing.

Division 1 will be run as **Double Elimination** (DE). The amount of teams placed in this Division will be decided from the results of the speed trials.

Divisions will be split across Saturday and Sunday.

# CAMPING AT THE SHOW

## CAMPING PITCHES

The camping field will be marked out with the number of pitches you have booked with your entry. There are a large number of people camping and a huge effort is involved in marking out the site to accommodate everyone.

Please keep within your designated camping pitches. You will not be able to camp if you have not pre-booked. Please book what you need with your entry and avoid amendments, there will be no camping amendments permitted after 17th July.

## SHOWERS

Showers will be available at all times on site over the 4-day event.

## ELSAN POINT

Please use the available elsan points for safe disposal of your toilet waste. Toilets must not be emptied in the public toilets.

# RULES & REGULATIONS

Please note that the Outdoor championships is a four day tournament and as such you may be racing, ring party or judging on any/all of the days. Please do not enter if you can not fulfil these requirements, refusal to partake in team responsibilities may jeopardise your entry into this & future BFA committee events.

1. The tournament organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any person not in good standing with the BFA.
2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament.

3. It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for its class and running order.
4. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
5. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
6. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
  - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
  - b. A danger to safety of any person or animal
  - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
7. All dogs enter the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
8. All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
9. BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
10. No alcohol is to be consumed within or around the ring. Smoking and vaping are not permitted within 15 feet of the flyball ring during competitions, or at presentations.
11. If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
12. On and around the flyball and camping fields a strict speed limit (**5 mph**) will apply, and vehicle movement restrictions will apply throughout the event.
13. Generators should be switched off no later than **10pm**.
14. Please be considerate to the rest of the camping fields when returning to your campsite in the evenings.

15. Please ensure you keep noise level to a minimum in the evening, especially after 11pm.
16. Please ensure you clear up after yourselves when using the toilet, shower facilities and marquee.
