# **CAMPING PITCHES**

The camping will be marked out with the number of pitches booked. Camping spaces are back-to-back. Your tow hitch **MUST** be to the road, no exceptions, this is for everyone's benefit. If you camp incorrectly, expect to be moved.

Please keep within your designated camping pitches. There is no camping without prior booking.

### ON SITE SHOWERS & TOILETS

Toilets will be available throughout the 3-day event. Please keep these clean to avoid unnecessary costly servicing. Please refrain from removing toilet rolls etc. The toilets are for humans only. See below for elsan information. Showers will be available at all times over the 3-day event. You are expected to bring your own towels etc.

# **ELSAN POINTS**

Please use the available elsan points around the site for safe disposal of your toilet waste. *Using the public toilets is strictly prohibited*.

# **RULES & REGULATIONS**

Please note the Indoor Championships is a 3-day tournament and as such you may be racing, ring party or judging on any/all days.

Refusal to partake in team responsibilities may jeopardise your entry into future BFA committee events.

- 1. The tournament organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any person not in good standing with the BFA.
- 2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament.
- 3. It is the **Team Captains** responsibility to ensure the Team is available for its division and running order.
- 4. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 5. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is strictly forbidden.
- 6. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
  - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
  - b. A danger to the safety of any person or animal
  - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete.
- 7. All dogs enter the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 8. All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 9. BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
- 10. No alcohol is to be consumed within or around the ring. Smoking and vaping are prohibited inside the buildings and at presentations.
- 11. If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.

- 12. A strict speed limit (5 mph) will apply to the whole site, vehicle movement restrictions will apply throughout the event. Anyone caught exceeding the speed limit will be removed from the site and the championships. 5 mph is WALKING pace. The speed limit is for the safety of your dogs and children.
- 13. Generators should be switched off no later than **10pm**.
- 14. Please be considerate to the rest of the camping fields when returning to your campsite in the evenings.
- 15. Please ensure you keep noise level to a minimum in the evening, especially after **11pm**.
- 16. **You** are responsible for clearing up after yourselves when using the toilets AND shower facilities.
- 17. Fire pits are strictly prohibited from the venue. BBQs should only be used if they are off the ground, anyone using a BBQ, must have quick and easy access to any or all and not limited to the following in case of an accident; sand, water, fire blanket, fire extinguisher. In the event of a fire please advise a member of the committee as soon as possible, damage to the venue will have to be paid for.
- 18. You are responsible for removing your rubbish from the function room after use as well as your campsite before you leave, red bins will be provided for your convenience. This is your job not the job of the Committee OR Champs Crew, additional charges may be incurred, these will be passed on to those responsible for any mess left behind.
- 19. And finally...this is our hobby, have fun, race well, be kind, be positive to humans and dogs. Remember the dogs don't know, they just want to race!
