## Show rules and regulations

1. The tournament organiser reserves the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing within the BFA.
2. Entries are only valid on completion of the appropriate payment to the Tournament Organiser (Section A1, Rule 3.3).
3. When the running orders are generated the tournament organiser will endeavour to accommodate teams who request specific days, however this cannot be guaranteed. If we cannot fulfil your request, no refund will be given unless we can fill the slot with another team. Thank you for your understanding.
4. In the unfortunate event of abandonment of the show through circumstances beyond the control of the organisers, expenses may be defrayed from the entry fees to cover the cost of the preparations for the show.
5. The organisers reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
6. BFA Rules and Policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
7. No person shall impugn the decision of the head judge or judges
8. All competitors and visitors are responsible for their dogs and must obey any “out of bounds” or restricted areas that are in place.
9. No ground level BBQs are allowed
10. No alcohol to be consumed within or around the ring
11. Smoking of tobacco products (including electronic/vaping type cigarettes) is not permitted in the flyball ring or within 15ft of the ring during competitions or at presentations.
12. It is the team captain’s responsibility to ensure the team is available for their divisions and running order.
13. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament.
14. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
15. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
  - a. suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
  - b. a danger to safety of any person or animal
  - c. likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
16. All dogs are entered in this event at their owners risk and, whilst every care will be taken, the event organisers cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
17. All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue immediately.

## Directions to Venue

Court Farm is located just north of Chippenham, Wiltshire, less than 3 miles from junction 17 of the M4 motorway.

Leave the M4 motorway at junction 17, taking the A429, signposted Cirencester / Kemble Airfield / Malmesbury. After approximately 1.6 miles, at the roundabout where you see an old aircraft hangar now used by the M4 Karting & Minimoto Circuit, take the first exit to leave the A429 signposted to Hullavington / Grittleton / Sherston. After just 400 yards, at the next roundabout, take the second exit signposted Hullavington. Continue along this road for approximately 1 mile, when you get to a crossroads you will see Court Farm on your right. Access to the flyball field is via the gate in front of you.

There will be a dedicated dog walking area on site, please ensure that you clean up after your dogs and use the bins provided in order that we can continue to use this venue for future competitions.

**Please Note:** There are horses on site, please stay away from their paddocks so as not to cause them any uneasiness or distress. Under no circumstances are any dogs allowed anywhere near the horses.
